EACB President Priscille Szeradzki appointed General Manager of the Confédération Nationale du Crédit Mutuel

Paris, 15/01/2026 - The General Assembly of the **Confédération Nationale du Crédit Mutuel (CNCM)** unanimously elected **Priscille Szeradzki** as General Manager. Her appointment will take effect on 1 February 2026. She succeeds **Isabelle Ferrand**, whose term began on 1 May 2023. Ms Szeradzki proposed **Emmanuelle Revolon** as her Deputy General Manager, which was endorsed by CNCM Board.

Priscille Szeradzki, General Manager of the Confédération Nationale du Crédit Mutuel, declared:
